A34. SURCHARGE TO FUND PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION
REIMBURSEMENT FEE

34.1 GENERAL INFORMATION

34.1.1 APPLICABILITY

All telecommunications carriers are required to apply the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) mandated Public Purpose Program surcharge on intrastate access lines and the CPUC Reimbursement Fee to intrastate services. The Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement Fee Surcharge is for the purpose of funding the Public Utilities Commission and applies to the aggregate amount of customer billings associated with intrastate services which appear on customers' bills.*

34.1.2 TERRITORY

Within the exchange areas of all exchanges as said areas are defined on maps filed as part of the tariff schedules.

34.2 RATES

As permitted by Public Utilities Code Section 492, and as required by CPUC Resolution T-16901, Ordering Paragraph 1, effective January 1, 2005, Sierra Telephone concurs with the Commission's Public Purpose Program surcharge and the Reimbursement Fee as filed by Pacific Bell Telephone Company (d.b.a. AT&T California) (Pacific Bell/AT&T California) in its joint tariff for surcharges and fees. Sierra Telephone will apply the current surcharge and fee rates filed in the joint tariff to its respective end user bills until further revised.

For the Public Purpose Program surcharge and Reimbursement Fee, and the current Commission-approved surcharge and fee rates, refer to the Pacific Bell/AT&T California tariff Schedules Cal. P.U.C. No. A1.1.10, Cal. P.U.C. No. A2, and/or Cal. P.U.C. No. A5. The Pacific Bell/AT&T California tariff schedules are available on-line at: <https://cpr.att.com/pdf/ca/ca.htm>.

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*In 1983 the Legislature established the Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement Fee to be paid by utilities to fund their regulation by the Commission (Public Utilities PU Code Section 401-433). The surcharge to recover the cost of that fee is ordered by the Commission under authority granted by Public Utilities Code Section 433.

34.3 SPECIAL CONDITIONS

A. The monthly percentage applies to all intrastate recurring and non-recurring rates and charges for service provided under all of the Utility's tariff schedules excluding yellow page directory revenues, direct sales, detariffed services, federal and local excise taxes, and the following:

1. Directory advertising and sales;
2. Terminal equipment sales;
3. Inter-utility sales;
4. Universal Lifeline Telephone Service (ULTS); and
5. Incarcerated Individuals.

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The surcharge is subject to federal and local excise tax.

B. This surcharge will be applied to the customer's bill for intrastate services that appear on that particular bill.
